Positive Behaviour Policy – Pupil Version

At Thomas Jones I follow these behaviour rules to keep us all safe and enable us to learn in a gentle and calm environment:

- I am consistently kind and friendly
- I am honest
- I am polite and helpful
- I focus on my learning and complete the tasks set
- I act upon advice and/or warnings immediately
- I respect others and have regard for authority
- I look after my belongings and the school premises
- I wear full Thomas Jones uniform

I know that I will be praised for positive behaviours and that my behaviour affects my ability to learn.

I trust staff to be consistent and fair when addressing positive and negative behaviour.

I know that all children have different needs and abilities but that it is important to follow the behaviour rules to keep us all safe and to enable us to learn.

Disruption will not be tolerated at Thomas Jones and I must not prevent others from learning.

I understand the ‘unacceptable behaviours’ and if I choose not to follow the behaviour expectations, I understand that there will be **sanctions**. A sanction could mean one or more of the following:

1. A verbal warning
2. Removal of break time
3. Removal from the classroom to reflect and recalibrate
4. Speak to a member of the leadership team
5. Loss of privileges (choosing time or special events)
6. A call home to parents or carers

Unacceptable behaviour in and around the school

- Running
- Using aggressive language
- Loitering inside the building
- Shouting
- Any form of verbal abuse
- Slamming doors
- Spitting
- Play fighting
- Vandalism
- Bullying
- Rudeness
- Leaving the school property without permission or adult supervision

Unacceptable behaviour in the playground

- Rude and offensive comments about others' families
- Pulling faces, rude gestures
- Verbal abuse of any kind
- Fighting or play fighting
- Any form of physical abuse
- Excluding peers from a game
- Improper use of equipment
- Not returning equipment
- Pushing/pulling
- Misuse of toilet and water facilities
- Damaging playground equipment
- Running or being loud in the Quiet Area
- Going to the water fountain after the bell has been rung
- Not lining up in silence
- Refusing to obey instructions
- Playing inside the building
